



Background

Our primary goal is inspire our students to complete their education and to graduate with a high school diploma. We must encourage all students to remain in school and to provide them with the educational, emotional and social support necessary to graduate.

Procedures

1. At the elementary school level, students will be provided with the provincial educational program adapted to meet the unique needs of the students in each of the communities. Every effort will be made to ensure that students have the academic skills and abilities to deal successfully with the junior and senior high school programs.
2. Where ever possible, students may be provided with an educational program, ECS to grade 12, in their home communities
3. At the junior high school level:
 - 3.1 The educational program will meet the academic and personal needs of each student through a combination of core and complementary programs and the elective components of each.
 - 3.2 Formal joint agreements may be entered into with other agencies and institutions in order to provide facilities and other resources in the community.
4. At the senior high school level:
 - 4.1 Required educational courses necessary for graduation with a provincial high school diploma will be offered.
 - 4.2 Counselling and program planning assistance will be available to each student prior to enrollment in high school.
 - 4.3 Students will be made aware that their choice of subjects may be governed, in some cases, by the availability of instructional resources and/or facilities within the community.
 - 4.4 The principal shall ensure that there is a student program plan in place for each student that provides an organized pattern of study leading into a future goal and/or career opportunity.



The program plan must be signed by the parent and the student and reviewed and updated annually.

- 4.5 Innovative approaches to the delivery of educational programs must be utilized in order to increase course and program offerings.
5. In an effort to provide an effective educational program in the most efficient manner, consideration must be given to the sharing of specialized teachers, provision of particular facilities and equipment, and the use of career and guidance counsellors that are aware and understanding of the needs and social context of students in the communities.
6. In the event that a student cannot be provided with an appropriate program that meets individual needs and educational goals, consideration for a boarding allowance will be given to attend school in another jurisdiction upon submission of an application.
7. The Local School Board Committee shall provide opportunities for parents, students and community members to receive information on the plans for school programs and assist in long term staffing needs.
