Student Admission To High School

Background

In order for students to be successful in their high school studies, it is critical that students begin regular attendance at the beginning of their classes in semestered schools.

Procedures

1. Students may be admitted to a semestered class up to three weeks after the semester has commenced. In such cases, credits will be granted if the student:
 - 1.1 Has maintained regular attendance in class.
 - 1.2 Has been able to catch up on the material covered prior to admission and maintained a satisfactory achievement level.
2. It is not recommended that students transfer from one school to another, either in or out of the division, after the initial three weeks of classes.
3. Students who drop out of a boarding home program situation will not be eligible to re-enter such a program until the beginning of the next school year/semester.
