- ✎ The Board approved the dates of the 2009-2010 Board Meetings as follows: April 15th, May 13th, June 10th and September 9th, 2010.
- ✎ The Board approved the conveyance allowance appeal for Case No. 2010-003 until the end of June 2010.
- ✎ The Board approved the suspension of the distribution of the Aboriginal Program Supervisor's salary of \$5,000 per school pending further budget analysis.
- ✎ The Board approved the 2008-2009 Audited Financial Statements.
- ✎ The Board recommended that administration not proceed with the concept of leasing Divisional vehicles at this time.
- ✎ The Board approved the Statement of Final Costs for the set up and delivery costs of a modular classroom for Little Buffalo School in the amount of \$555,978.
- ✎ The Board authorized the administration to enter into negotiations with the Lubicon Lake First Nation to place a trailer on the school site at Little Buffalo.
- ✎ The Board approved changes to the IMR Project list.
- ✎ The Board approved the withdrawal of the Statement of Final Costs for the CTS mobile lab for resubmission at a later date.
- ✎ The Board approved the request from Standard Life to reimburse School Food Services staff with less than two years of service the employer's share of the contribution, due to the mandatory transfer to LAPP.
- ✎ The Board accepted the tender from Jacknife Timber Ltd., for the purchase of the School Food Services equipment in the amount of \$1,000 on an 'as is, where is' basis with the equipment to be removed by Jacknife Timber Ltd., prior to March 19th, 2010. No other bids were received.
